Projects for which funding is sought must be of a clear research nature. You can only apply for support for one year at a time. In the case of multi-year projects, a progress plan must be presented. You are not guaranteed support over several years for a multi-year project, even if the application is granted in the first year.

Research funding is primarily awarded to established researchers, with preference for projects that are within the Institute's prioritised research areas.

Research fellows and postdoc fellows are not normally granted funding, since it is assumed that the host institution covers necessary operating expenses for such projects.

We do not support foreign researchers who wish to conduct research outside Norway, nor applications to invite foreign speakers to conferences in Norway.

The applicant must state why their own institution cannot finance the funding for which funding is sought.

In addition to the project description (2-4 pages), the budget for the project with a precise indication of travel expenses and subsistence allowance must be attached as a separate document.
